Alan Cowley - Alan is now able to move around a little with the aid of some crutches and a frame but he is still very bruised

Pauline Kelly - Please pray for Pauline and her family as they prepare for Pete's funeral later on next week

Frank Kohler - Frank is now in Southmead Hospital. His legs are still very bad. As I write, it is still very unclear what the next moves of his medical team might be. Please pray for Frank and for Mandy as this is a very difficult time for them
