FELLOWSHIP NEWS

For once I am not going to go through a long list of people. Most of those who have been mentioned in recent editions are stable at the moment or are slowly improving. Nevertheless, please continue to pray for them. However, I would highlight a couple of people:

Rebecca Mason – Many of you already receive our longer notes. But a brief summary is that Rebecca is getting much stronger in her upper body and is able to use an ordinary wheelchair now. Most importantly she is continuing to respond very well to her ongoing arsenic treatment for her leukemia. However, we continue to be frustrated by her broken digestive system and her continual nausea and sickness. Lance has managed to get to see Rebecca twice since Christmas, but there is a distinct possibility that visitors won't be allowed in much longer which will clearly have a big impact.

Christine Richards – As you know Gordon and Pat's daughter died, just before Christmas, after many years of very severe health problems. Gordon, Pat and their son Glyn had Covid over Christmas. Please find your own words to pray over Gordon and Pat. Christine's funeral will be at 10.30am on Monday 10th January in Weston-super-Mare.
