### **MOLDOVA**

Things go up and down. Andrei's view of things fluctuates almost daily. However, a few days ago I received the following message from Vasile Grigorita, a pastor in Brinza (about an hour south of Burlacu) ...

I write to you about the current situation related to the war in Ukraine and the situation in Moldova. Things are not going well at all. The Russian army in the meantime withdrew from the northern region of Ukraine but began a strong offensive in South Eastern Ukraine, very close to us. The situation is very tense in Moldova because of the provocateurs in Transnistria, recently someone attacked the headquarters of an administrative institution in Transnistria, it was an attack with grenade launchers, a reason for Transnistria to accuse Moldova of attacking it so that the Russian army could intervene to defend the Transnistrian citizens who mostly have Russian citizenship. I call you to pray with us especially these days for Moldova. We pray that peace will be preserved in our country and that God will stop the war in Ukraine. Please pass this information on.

The situation in Moldova, particularly in the breakaway republic of Transnistria, is tense. Many Ukrainians choose to flee to Moldova as so many people there speak Russian. The President, Maia Sandu, is doing a really great job at walking a difficult tightrope. I will update you as and when things change.

## **BAPTISM**

We are looking forward to holding a service of believer's baptism soon, probably sometime in June. If any of you have not been baptised (by full immersion), I would encourage you to give it some thought and talk to me if you would like to consider this important step of witness and obedience.
