He said that the recent power outages in Moldova, as a result of Russian bombing of Ukraine, actually affected the whole country for a couple of hours. We talked about all sorts of things, especially the way in which their president, Maia Sandu, is trying to steer the country away from their Soviet past, but she is encountering considerable opposition from those who would happily return to that past. He thanks all in the church for our support for him and sends his love and warmest greetings.
